<b>English&amp; Science (Individual Activity )</b>	Report Booklet Based on Outdoor observation	Students will observe their home or neighborhood environment and create a Report Booklet describing urban features like buildings, parks, roads, and playgrounds, along with environmental aspects such as trees, water sources, and waste management.The same to be presented in class.	A4 size sheets, coloured pens, picture cut outs, pencils etc.	The booklet will be prepared at home and presented in class
<b>Punjabi (Group Activity )</b>	City scape collage	Students will make a Cityscape Collage by pasting a picture showing city life (e.g., traffic, workers, vendors) and write a few sentences in Punjabi explaining what it reveals about urban living.	Picture cut outs, scissors, glue, A4 size sheets	To be done in class
<b>Maths &amp; SSt (Group activity)</b>	Urban planning Simulation	Students will work in groups to design and create their Dream Eco-City using A3 sheets or recycled materials (like cardboard, boxes, and paper). They will draw or build a city layout showing important places such as parks, schools, hospitals, and roads using basic shapes (circles, rectangles, squares).Students will also explainhow their city helps people live happily and peacefully.
