ENG	SAVOUR THE FLAVOUR (Recipe Book) (Group Activity)	Students will create a recipe book with 5 recipe in a groups, including pictures and proper formatting.. Each student will present one recipe individually, explaining its preparation and significance.	A4 Size sheets, coloured pens, Cut out of images	To be made at home and presented in Class.
HINDI	POVERTY ALLEVIATION (Individual Activity)	Each student will compose a short rhyming poem in Hindi on the topic “Poverty Alleviation.” The poem should express ideas about helping the poor, kindness, sharing, equality, and making the world a better place for everyone. Students will write the poem on an A4 sheet at home (10–12 lines) and recite it in class.	A4 size sheet Pencil / Pen Sketch pens	To be done at home and present in class.
PBI	POVERTY ALLEVIATION (Individual Activity)	The teacher will write questions on cue cards. Each student will be given one cue card. After thinking for one to two minutes, the student will be asked to express their thoughts.	No material required	To be done in the class.
MATH	SYMMETRY IN ARCHITECTURE (Individual Activity)	Design your own symmetrical building on an A4 size plain sheet and draw lines of symmetry.	A4 sized sheets, colours	To be done in school
G.P	HUNGRY FOR CHANGE (Group Activity)	Students will create a “Food Waste Awareness Chart” showing how food is wasted at home or school and ways to reduce it. They will collect information through observation or discussion with family, then design a colorful chart suggesting simple actions like sharing food, using leftovers, and avoiding over-serving.
