<b>Hindi (Individual Activity)</b>	Blog on Education Access	Students will write a blog post in Hindi focusing on the importance of education access for all. Pictures can be used to enhance the overall impact.	A4 sized sheets, coloured Pens, Picture cutouts etc.	To be done in class
<b>Punjabi (Individual Activity)</b>	Poster Making	Students will design a poster in Punjabi promoting education access. They may include motivational quotes, key messages, and visuals encouraging people to value education as a tool for empowerment.	A4 sized sheets, Cutouts, coloured Pens etc.	To be done in class
<b>Science+ Math (Individual Activity)</b>	Mapping Educational Inequalities (Visual display)	Students will compare literacy, enrollment, or dropout data across multiple regions/states (Any 3) for last 5 years and present in the form of charts, percentages, or ratios to highlight disparities. Students will also study the factors that affect attendance and continuation in school, and present their findings through a chart or visual display.
