Punjabi (Individual Activity)	Smart sustainable City	Students will imagine and creatively describe a smart and sustainable city in Punjabi, including illustrations. SCIENCE (Individual Activity)	Circuit Sparks	Students will construct a simple electric circuit using basic materials to understand the flow of electricity and present the working model in class	1 small bulb (1.5V), 2-3 wires, 1 battery (9 Volt), Connector, Tape, A small switch, Connector	To be done in class
MATHS (Individual Activity)	Maps and Plans	Students will create a hand-drawn map or plan of a familiar area (school or neighbourhood park) on a sheet by choosing a suitable scale, marking accurate distances, labelling key locations, and including directions and a key to show mathematical representation of real places. G.P. (Individual Activity)	Trash to Treasure	Students will create an upcycled product by transforming waste materials into items of higher value, demonstrating creativity and environmental responsibility.
