Science + Mathematics + (Individual Activity)	Label Detectives	Students will compare the labels of three packaged food products by analysing ingredients, nutritional values, manufacturing and expiry dates, certifications, and price. They will calculate the cost per 100 g (or 100 mL), compare nutritional values, and recommend the healthiest and most economical choice with scientific and mathematical justification.	Three packaged food products (or photographs of their labels), A4 Size Sheets etc.	Analysis of the labels, calculations, and observation report to be made in class.
Social Science + English (Group Activity)	Group Discussion	Students will participate in a group discussion in groups of five (Roll No. wise) on the given topics • Need vs. Want – How Can We Make Wise Buying Decisions? • Why Is It Important to Read Product Labels and Check Expiry Dates? • Should We Always Buy Branded Products? • Online Shopping vs. Offline Shopping – Which Makes a Smarter Consumer? • How Do Advertisements and Social Media Influence Our Purchases? Can Expensive Products Be a Waste of Money?	-	Research to be done prior for presentation in class.
Hindi (Group Activity)	Mock Consumer Court	Students will conduct a mock consumer court where students play the roles of judge, complainant, shopkeeper, lawyer, and consumer rights officer to resolve a consumer complaint.	Simple props/charts (optional)	Script to be prepared prior and to be presented in class.

Technology (Individual Activity)	Micro:bit Logic Board	Students will Create a simple program in MakeCode using If–Then–Else statements to simulate a smart pH tester (e.g., <i>If $pH < 7 \rightarrow Acidic$; Else $\rightarrow Safe$</i>). Submit the logic design or screenshot of the program in printed form.	Computer/laptop with internet access	To be mailed at official email id that will be shared by Class incharge.
