English + Social Science + Engineering (Group Activity)	The Mini Eco-Park Model	Students will design and build a sustainable eco-park model. They will create habitats, classify animals into vertebrates and invertebrates, and display park rules promoting responsible citizenship towards nature.	Cardboard base, toy animals/cut-outs, coloured paper, twigs, leaves, ice-cream sticks, glue, scissors, sketch pens, etc.	To be done in class.
Science + Mathematics (Individual Activity)	Nature Survey	Students will observe 12 living organisms in the school surroundings, classify them as plants, birds, insects, mammals, reptiles etc and represent their observations using tally marks and a pictograph.	A4 drawing sheet/chart paper, ruler, pencil, colours	To be done in school.
Hindi (Individual Activity)	प्रकृति का संदेश (कविता)	Students will give an expressive oral presentation/recitation of an original 8–12 line Hindi poem. The poem should highlight the need to preserve the nature.	A4 sheet, pen/pencil, colours.	To be prepared at home and presented in class.
Punjabi (Group Activity)	ਕੁਦਰਤ ਦੇ ਰੱਖਿਅਕ (Campaigning)	Students will assume the role of Green Citizens and present a 1–2 minute awareness campaign in Punjabi, inspiring the community to become responsible guardians of nature and preserve its natural patterns. Technology (Individual Activity)	Digital Poster – "Be a Green Citizen!"
