Subject	Topic	Nature of Task	Required Material (To be sent from home)	Class/Home Work
Science + English (Group Activity)	The Extreme Habitat Survival Model	Each group will select one extreme habitat (Polar Region, Desert, Rainforest, or Deep Ocean) and create a 3D model using recycled materials. They will place 3-4 animals showing their adaptations and prepare a Habitat Information Card describing the habitat, climate, animal adaptations, and one conservation measure.	A box, coloured paper, cotton, sand, clay, glue, scissors, recycled materials	Research to be done at home. The model and the information card to be prepared in class.
Social Science (Individual Activity)	Journey of Early Humans	Create a timeline chart illustrating the stages of early humans. Include simple illustrations, one important feature, one tool used, and one major lifestyle change for each stage.	A4 size sheet, colours, pencil, scissors, glue, picture cut outs	Research to be done at home and the timeline to be prepared in class.
Mathematics (Individual Activity)	Math Challenge Booklet	Design a mini booklet containing 5 real-life multiplication and division Word problems based on habitats, animals, and early humans. Solve each problem neatly with proper working.	A4 sheets, pencil/pen, ruler, colours	To be done in class.
Punjabi (Individual Activity)	Diary Entry	Imagine yourself as an early human and write a diary entry (Word Limit: 80-100 words) describing your daily life, food, shelter, tools, challenges, and how your tribe worked together to survive.	A4 sheet, pen/pencil	To be done in class.
Hindi (Pair Activity)	Stone Age News Bulletin	Students will work in pairs to present a 1–2 minute Hindi news bulletin set in the Stone Age. One student will act as the News Anchor, and the other will act as a Stone Age character (such as a Hunter, Tribe Leader, Tool Maker, or Cave Resident) being interviewed or reporting live.	Simple props (paper microphone, cue cards, headband – optional)	Script to be prepared prior and to be presented in class.
Technology (Group Activity)	Habitat Quiz	Design an interactive Canva presentation with 8–10 quiz questions on habitats, animal adaptations, and early humans. Students may include multiple-choice, true/false, and picture-based questions, and conduct the quiz in class.	-	To be mailed at official email id that will be shared by Class incharge.
